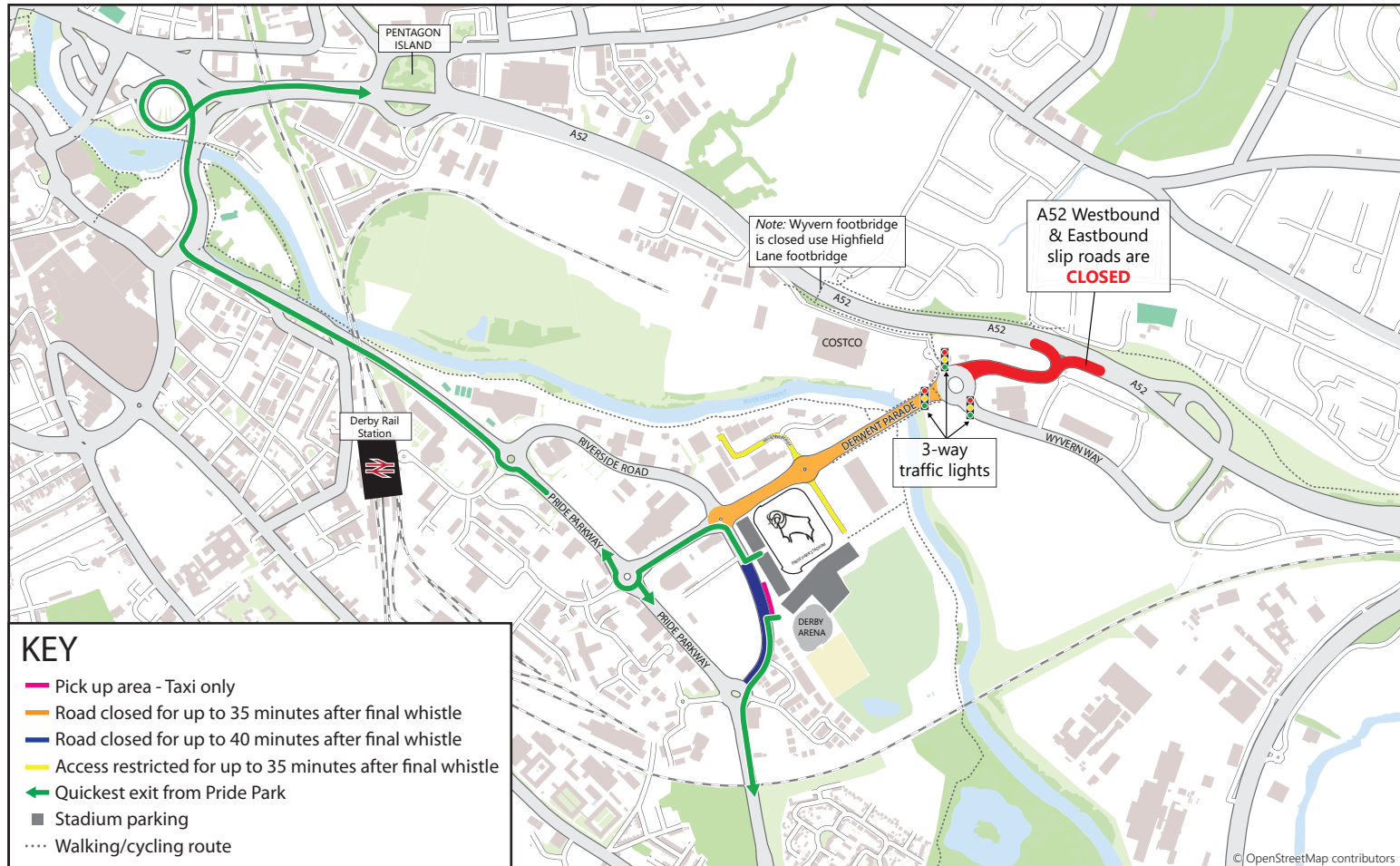


# Post-Match Traffic Management on Pride Park

## Important information: A52 roadworks



## Leaving Pride Park Post-Match

- From the start of the 2019/20 football season the west-bound entry and exit slip roads from the A52 into the Wyvern area are closed for major improvement works.
- We anticipate local roads and car parks will take longer to clear post-match, so thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation.
- Derwent Parade will continue to be closed between the Wyvern Way roadworks and island 2 for up to 35 minutes after each DCFC home to ensure pedestrian safety.

### Travelling away from the stadium by car:

- Ensure you follow the signed diversions, which will direct most traffic away from the stadium via Pride Parkway and London Road (A6).
- Cars parked in the South and West car parks will be released once post-match restrictions to ensure pedestrian safety have been lifted (up to 40 mins after the final whistle).
- Three-way traffic lights will operate 24/7 for the Wyvern roadworks.
- Vehicles exiting via the A52, will only be able to head Eastbound (towards M1/Nottingham).

### Travelling on foot:

- The Wyvern footbridge is also closed for refurbishment, please use the Highfield Lane footbridge to cross the A52.
